What we're about

Our intent is to create an environment where members can help each other grow in pursuit of their writing goals.

We typically meet on Thursday evenings (though we have meetings on other nights too) at a variety of venues—check meeting announcements for specifics.

- The first Thursday of each month is reserved for a Meet-n-Greet. Here we announce group business, and then open it up for general discussion and to welcome new members. This is an informal means of getting to know each other and provide support for all members.
- The third Thursday of each month is our 'main event'. This may be a presentation or a workshop of some kind. Presentation topics have included: dealing with writer's block, how to write an erotic scene, dialogue, issues over POV, traditional versus self-publishing, and many others. The more popular presentation topics may be moved to the Bent Mast pub on a Monday evening.
- We also run talks for guest speakers, write-ins, critiques, and show-n-tells on other weeks.
